

Hair Professional (ST0213) Level 2 Apprenticeship

There are two distinctly different job roles within this occupational profile: Hairdresser and Barber.

Hairdressers will be able to shampoo and condition hair, cut hair using a range of techniques, style and finish hair to create variety of looks, and colour and lighten hair for ladies and men.

Barbers will be able to shampoo and condition hair, cut hair using barbering techniques, style and finish hair, cut facial hair into shape and provide shaving services for men.

Expected course duration

24 Months

College attendance

Bedford College (Brooks) - Monday or Wednesday. Central Bedfordshire College – Monday. Tresham College (Kettering Campus) - Monday or Wednesday.

College day release intakes

Day release begins in September.

When can the apprentice start employment?

July/August.

When can the apprenticeship training start?

Bedford College (Brooks) - As soon as employment starts.

Central Bedfordshire College – September.

Tresham College (Kettering Campus) - As soon as employment starts.
