- Install, commission, service and maintain domestic plumbing and heating systems
- Specific domestic core safety for natural gas
- Install and maintain gas water heating and wet central heating appliances



## **Entry requirements**

#### Grade requirements...

- Level 2 Functional Skills Maths and English
- GCSE grade 4 and above Maths and English

## Other requirements...

#### **Essential:**

Level 1 Equivalent or Grade 3 and above Maths and English

## What training is required in the workplace?

- Learning a variety of skills to enable the apprentice to be able to develop and complete their Apprenticeship and EPA
- 20% off the job training
- College attendance
- Regular 10/12/week Meetings with Training Coordinator, Manager and Apprentice to discuss progress and set SMART targets throughout apprenticeships
